This concept, with its emphasis on individual autonomy, personal decision-making and the protection of privacy, is and has always been at the centre of medical ethics and law.

The usual challenges which surround the process of obtaining informed consent have, arguably, been made more complex as a result of the Covid-19 pandemic.
